CHARITABLE OUTREACH


Hi All,

Thanks to Cynthia from **Cynthia's Fine Fabrics** for the informative talk about batting.

We learned many things about betting including the 4 C's -

Clean: No plant material caught in the fibers

Color White, natural, black, and green (choose correctly)

Count: How many inches apart should you quilt

Cotton.: % of shrinkage to expect using a pure cotton and, depending on the project, when to use another batting material

The take away—check the batting package labels and feel free to ask Cynthia for her advice!
